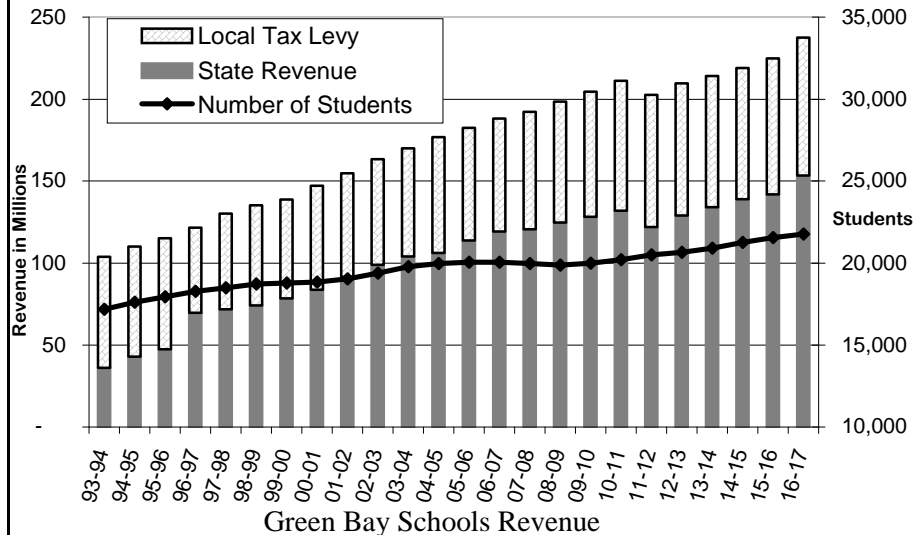

## Dear Fellow Taxpayer

The state has increased funding of your schools, but the Green Bay District has not used the money to reduce your tax burden – but other districts have! Over the past two years, school property tax rates are Down 11.9% in Pulaski, Down 9% in West De Pere, Down 9.3% in Kenosha, Down 3.2% in Ashwaubenon, and Down 8.8% in Milwaukee. Green Bay's rate is Up 1.3%.

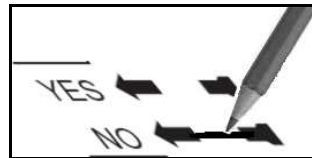
Now, the District is asking you to authorize an additional \$16.5 million in property taxes **Each Year for the next Ten years!**
